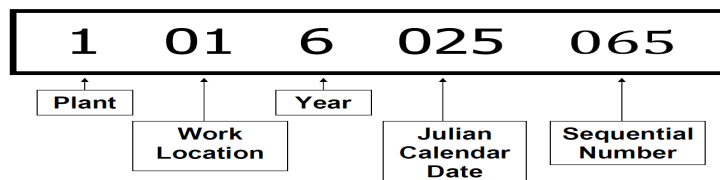
RE: **Lot/Batch Code Statement**

Ingredion uses a 10-digit code for product lot or batch number identification. The lot (Batch) codes are unique by the manufacturing facility, material code, pack code and work location within the plant.

- a) The first character (1-9) denotes the manufacturing facility:
 - 1 Argo (Bedford Park, Illinois)
 - 2 Cardinal (Ontario)
 - 3 London (Ontario)
 - 6 Winston-Salem (North Carolina)
 - 7 Mapleton (Illinois) & Breakstation or Toll Packer
- b) The second and third character (00-99) denote a work location within a manufacturing facility.
- c) The fourth character denotes the year.
- d) The fifth, sixth and seventh characters denote the Julian Calendar day of the year.

The eighth, ninth and tenth characters are sequential number of the lot produced at the location on a particular day.
