Explanation of Batch Code – Pulse Products

This batch code explanation applies to the following pulse products:

1. HOMECRAFT® Pulse 1101, 1103, 1135, 2101, 2103, 2135, 3101, 3103, 4101, 4135, 5101, 5135, 6101, 6135, CT 1203, CT 2201, CT 2203, CT 3203, CT 4201
2. VITESSENCE® Pulse 1550, 155030, 2550, 3600, CT 3602, CT 1552, 1803, 1803 Organic, 1853, 1803C, 1803D
3. PURITY® P 1002
4. HOMECRAFT® Prista P 101, P211, P 301
5. VITESSENCE® Prista P 155, P 360
6. HOMECRAFT® Quinoa 112
7. VITESSENCE® TEX Crumbles 102, Crumbles 1651, Granules 1651
8. VITESSENCE® Pulse 1556, 1556 B
9. PURITY® P 1304, P 1304B, P1306, P1306B
10. Pea Protein PF 70000511

The batch code applied to the bulk truck, bag or tote will be one of the codes described below.

Batch Code A

Batch Code system consists of:

- First letter = month of production (letter I is omitted); A(January), B (February), C(March), D(April), E(May), F(June), G(July), H(August), J(September), K(October), L(November) and M(December).
- Second letter = year of production (letter I is omitted) – F (2016), G (2017), H (2018), J (2019), K (2020), A (2021), B / M (2022)*, N (2023), P (2024).
- Third letter = manufacturing location - X = South Sioux City, NE, I = NA tollers, Y = Vanscoy, SK, Canada.
- 4 digits = batch number

*changed from B to M effective for batches made after Oct 1, 2022 for USA and EU

A typical batch number would be similar to BAX0012 or KAY2002

Batch Code B

Batch Code system consists of

- First 4 numbers - product number
- Next 3 numbers - Julian date
- Last 2 numbers – year

A typical batch number would be similar to 110103520 representing Homecraft Pulse 1101 packaged Feb 4 in 2020

Batch Code C

The lot number is based on the production date. For example, if product was produced on May 14th, 2017, the lot number would be 20170514.

Batch Code D

Ingredion uses a 10-character code to identify lots or batches of pulse products (HOMECRAFT® Pulse Flours and VITESSENCE® Pulse Proteins). The first 5 characters are AGT-M, followed by a 5-digit sequential number.

A typical batch number would be similar to AGT-M10000.

Batch Code E

The batch code consists of 6 digits and utilizes the Julian Date, the last digit of the year of manufacture, the production line, and the production shift.

Example: 036521

036 = The thirty sixth day of the year, in this case February 5th.

5 = The last digit of the year of manufacture, in this case 2015

2 = The line the product was produced on, in this case, line #2.

1 = The shift that produced product, in this case 1st shift.

The batch code explanation applies to VITESSENCE® Pulse 1556 Protein pellets:

PP-000277. PP is for Protein Pellets followed by a sequential number that is the raw material bin number that finished product was produced from.
